Made specifically for primary school teachers, it combines:


- **Practical CPD training** designed to build your creative confidence to facilitate learning through the arts.

Benedetti Foundation - Dorset Residency



Dorset Music Hub is working in partnership with the <u>Benedetti Foundation</u> to offer a very special opportunity to a limited number of schools and string players from across our county this autumn.

The Benedetti Foundation was created by internationally acclaimed violinist Nicola Benedetti. The Residency Sessions provide a motivational opportunity for young people, instrumentalists and non-instrumentalists alike, and a source of support and uplift for teachers. During the residency, the Benedetti Foundation team will visit local schools to lead primary music workshops and host professional development sessions for primary classroom teachers and instrumental teachers, as well as delivering a Benedetti Sessions Strings Day.

- While we can only offer the school sessions to a limited number of schools, please look out for more information about the Strings Day as this is open to string players from across Dorset's schools.
- Wednesday 11th October: twilight CPD open to *all* Dorset school staff who are interested in delivering music in the classroom more information to follow.
- As part of the residency, the Benedetti Foundation will also be offering a session for string and instrumental teachers.



Financial support for young musicians - Changing Key Dorset

The deadline for applications for funding awards available this term is approaching soon!

Our Hub partner charity, <u>Changing Key Dorset</u>, offers funding awards for up to £300 per year to young musicians facing challenging circumstances.

Applications for funding from Changing Key Dorset are welcomed from any young musician educated across Dorset, including the wider BCP area. The funding can be used to support a variety of musical activities provided by private or public providers and lasts for up to three consecutive academic terms.

Applications can be made online at anytime - however there are closing dates for each term.

The application deadline for grants beginning this term is Friday 15th September 2023

• Spring Term 2024 closing date – Friday 1st December 2023

• Summer Term 2024 closing date – Friday 1st March 2024

Creative Music Nurture Groups



An exciting new offer from Dorset Music Hub to help boost the resilience and confidence of your most vulnerable pupils.

After a successful pilot of Creative Musical Nurture Groups (CMNGs) last academic year in Weymouth, DMH is delighted that we can now expand this offer across the whole county.

A CMNG is a weekly creative, instrumental music session for 3-5 children in KS2 or KS3. Participants are identified by schools as being vulnerable and at risk of poor outcomes due to mental health, behaviour, or general confidence difficulties.

The CMNG provides a calm and nurturing environment where children can build their resilience and agency and develop a sense of belonging through music.

Each CMNG of 3-5 children has a cost of £400, based around 1 term's delivery - Dorset Music Hub will fund 25% of the cost. For advice on how to fund the remaining £300, <u>please contact your</u> Education Challenge Lead at your local locality office.

If you have pupils who you think would benefit from a CMNG, please discuss this offer with your SENCo as they will need to be involved throughout the process.
